Footnotes

FOX IN THE HOUSE was unhurried early, bid inside into the stretch, angled out near the eighth pole, closed willingly, drifted out in tight quarters late and got up in the final strides. BEAR FAMOUS TRIP was never far off the pace, rallied around the turn, closed willingly, appeared to jump tracks near the sixteenth pole, was carried out and in tight quarters late and got up at the wire for second. DON'T DEFY ME settled off the pace, rallied into the turn to challenge, inched away for a short lead, led to deep stretch, was outfinished and lost position late. LEEDSTHEWAY sprinted clear to set the pace while racing in hand to the second turn and was unable to sustain his bid. BRITISH COLUMBIA raced in the back, closed steadily to narrow the gap and was not a threat. ST PATRICKS APPEAL raced in the middle of the pack, bid inside leaving the turn and had little left for the drive. KENTUCKY MILE trailed the field. Following a stewards inquiry, FOX IN THE HOUSE was disqualified and placed second for causing interference in late stretch.
