PLENTY DUE broke in some, set the pace and responded willingly in the drive then yielded grudgingly. STORMIN ARVIN bumped at the start, chased and weakened in the drive. WILLIAM WALLACE also bumped at the start, trailed on the turn then offered a belated gain. MAGICAL SATURDAY moved outside on the turn and lacked a rally. DA MICK lacked a bid. BESSEMER VICTORY broke a bit awkwardly, raced outside into the turn and weakened.
