UNQUIET bore out on the first turn, assumed command, set the pace and drew off in the drive under urging. ESPRESSO SPRINGS set the early pace, fell back to stalk inside, lacked the needed late rally but held for second. FRANSOR'S FINEST trailed the field, went six wide entering the stretch and closed well to get up for show. GO TO THE PULPIT lagged early, went five wide leaving the turn and offered a mild bid only. RAINIER ICE was taken back at the start, saved ground, bid inside on the turn and hung in the lane. MR. PADRE raced close to the pace, tired in the second turn and stopped.
