STRAWBERRYFIELDS dueled throughout and prevailed in an all out effort. WALK WEST raced mid pack off the rail, moved up to challenge four wide on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outnodded to just miss. QUITE A DANCER was unhurried early, advanced around the far turn, lacked room and angled out at the top of the stretch, was blocked and altered course near the eighth pole and closed in a game effort. FASHION DIAMOND bobbled a bit at the start, saved ground while racing in the back, bid inside, lacked room mid stretch and lost momentum. WHITEHOUSESTRYST was hustled along to set a pressured pace and gave way past the eighth pole. APRIL SEVEN raced off the rail, advanced to mid stretch to get within striking distance but came up empty. NEW RIVER STAR broke awkwardly, was never far back inside, was through after a half and stopped on the second turn. SCHMOOEY distanced the field.
