GOODBYE CHARLIE pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, drew clear and extended his lead under mild urging. GLORIA'S LUCKY ONE pressed the pace inside, fell back into the turn, angled out for the drive, bid five wide, couldn't gain ground and finished second best. LIVIN' LOVIN' MAN raced mid pack outside, went six wide entering the stretch, closed well, didn't have enough late but was clearly best of the rest. KATHLEEN'S TOUCH lagged early, saved ground, bid off the rail on the turn and improved position. RICH'S BOY was steadied at the start, was never far off the pace, bid to get within striking distance and came up empty. RADIANT RASCAL was off slowly and failed to threaten in an even effort. GREAT RIDE was slow early, got though along the rail on the turn, lacked a rally and failed to threaten. THUNDER STYLE was not a factor. CLARA'S IRISH BOY set the pace to the turn and stopped.
