CANDY LADY BAR was carried out on the first turn, stalked the pace to the second turn, challenged for the lead, dueled through the stretch, drifted in late and proved best. TRICK SKATE was rated along the rail, moved up along the rail on the backstretch, dueled through the stretch, was pushed in late and outfinished in a game effort. STOLEN FORUM raced close to the pace inside, eased out in the upper stretch, bid, didn't have enough left and failed to gain. LIZA STORM lagged, went four wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. IRISH BEST broke sharply, ducked in at the gap, was taken up, trailed once straightened and had no stretch response. KATIE SCHILLER failed to threaten in an even effort. EARLY GIRL set the pace, bore out on the first turn, bolted on the second turn and dropped back.
