SEVERED TIES broke alertly and drew well clear in the run to the turn, showed the way to the lane then was under left handed pressure while holding to the wire. A TRAIN ALEXIS broke a bit slowly, saved ground to the stretch, eased off the inside passing the eighth pole, drifted slightly soon thereafter then finished willingly. GOOD MANGO well placed outside, raced four wide entering the lane and gained some late. ORIENT ROSE pressed through the opening stages then chased, raced off the inside and lacked the needed stretch response. SOCIETY ROSE broke a bit slowly, trailed and lacked a rally. LUCKY MONIQUE also broke a bit slowly, raced just off the inside on the turn and tired through the lane.
