HECTOR saved ground into the far turn and just off the inside passing the quarter pole, was eased out while behind rivals into the lane then finished gamely to prevail. DESERT TRAIN advanced four wide turning for home and battled through the lane, held the advantage in deep stretch then just missed. CASE SETTLED came out some at the start, set the pace inside and responded gamely in the drive then held on well while not quite good enough. SEATTLE MEMO broke a bit slowly, prompted the issue three deep and weakened in the drive. CERTAINLY CERTAIN saved ground while well placed and lacked the needed response. SECRET CITY fractious in the gate, prompted the pace on the backstretch and rounding the final turn between rivals and tire din the drive. TREE TOP in a bit close at the start to be away a bit awkwardly, trailed and lacked a rally. PREACHER'S THREAT broke a bit slowly, raced off the inside into the far turn and lacked a bid.
