UNBRIDLED FURY broke out some then up close while saving ground, eased just off the inside on the final turn and reached the front in upper stretch, drew clear then held a rival safe through the late stages. FREEDOM'S HALO broke a bit awkwardly, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, chased and finished willingly while second best. LEWDAGW N PARADISE broke awkwardly, moved out and lodged a four wide bid on the final turn, stumbled nearing the quarter pole, continued in the four path into the lane then offered a mild gain while bobbling passing the sixteenth pole. SABINO STORM near the rail into the far turn, moved three wide for the drive and offered a belated gain. OZILDA'S LAST SON up close early and between foes into the far turn, raced along the inside turning for home and lacked the needed bid. TEACHER'S EDITION drew clear early, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened in the drive. STEEL BLUE broke a bit slowly, moved up in the run down the backstretch while three wide then weakened into the lane.
