Footnotes

APPLY four wide into the clubhouse turn, prompted the issue outside a rival, took over on the second turn and drew clear then drew off through the lane under strong urging. BRITISH COLUMBIA lunged out some at the break, bid five wide on the second turn and earned the place. WESTERN STRIDER four wide into the far turn, offered a late gain. MR MAHAL near the rail leaving the backstretch, was four wide into the lane and lacked the needed late bid. BANDINI'S DREAM between foes early, saved ground into the far turn and lacked a bid. COOKIE'S FROM TONY was in the three path into the stretch and also needed a late bid. BIG FAT STORM three wide into the clubhouse turn, set the early pace inside and tired through the lane. BATTLE SCHOOL raced well placed to the far turn and weakened then was not urged late.
