Footnotes

TOMMY TWO STROKE raced close to the pace, bid off the rail entering the stretch, closed steadily, got up past the sixteenth pole and drew clear. GAUL was never far off the pace, went five wide leaving the turn, closed willingly and got up at the wire for second. MR. GOODFELLOW ducked in at the gap and was steadied, set the pace, drew off on the turn, held a clear lead, yielded past the sixteenth pole and was caught at the wire for place. SACRED GHOST pressed the pace, fell back into the turn, went evenly late and lacked the needed rally. YOU DONE GOOD broke slowly and was pinched back at the start, raced mid pack, bid inside on the turn and hung. DYNAWAKI broke in, showed good early speed, fell back and went evenly thereafter. COSTAPLENTE was not a factor. SUNSOLEIL lagged outside, went five wide entering the stretch and did not threaten. MATTY O'KEEFE went six wide entering the stretch, lacked a bid and was outrun.
