UNBROKEN VOW raced mid pack, rallied four wide on the second turn, closed well and drew off past the sixteenth pole. TONY THE PONY was never far off the pace, rallied three wide on the second turn, dueled past the sixteenth pole and was outclosed to finish second best. INTERMISSION vied two across, faltered near the sixteenth pole but held for show. LAINIES LION was unhurried early, rallied around the turn, bid three wide, closed steadily and was gaining for show. BROCTANE (NZ) was unhurried early and offered a mild bid only despite steady urging. ESPORTE DOS REIS (BRZ) was not a threat. MOOSE LAKE advanced along the rail into the second turn to loom a threat but came up empty in the drive. CAPETOWN TIGER set the pace to the upper stretch, tired and stopped. GARY THE GORILLA raced inside, was through early, was eased in the stretch and walked off.
