Footnotes

ILLINOIS PINUP took charge shortly after the start, set the pace, widened into the stretch and was ridden out while maintaining the margin. LAZEKA broke out and took up at the start to fall behind field, was six wide moving on the turn then finished well through the drive. LEADING LINE raced four wide much of the trip and didn't seriously threaten the top pair but was clear of the rest of the field. BRITE NAVY was just off the early leaders, raced inside and lacked a late bid. OUR KITTEN eased out and was seven wide into the stretch but lacked a solid bid. DIANETOMEETCHA was forcing the pace while three wide, stayed in contention to the stretch then weakened. WHISKERS AND RYE had an inside trip but lacked a stretch bid. SONHO had a good position into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and tired. QUEEN JOYCE was slow after the start, saved ground on the turn but was not a factor.
