SUDDEN EXCESS stalked inside, was crowded and bumped along the backstretch, bid along the rail on the turn, angled out, closed well, got up late and won going away. EMANCIPATED pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled to deep stretch, was outclosed but held for place. SHORTY SMALL set a pressured pace, came in along the backstretch, dueled to deep stretch, was outfinished but best of the rest. FIERCE ACT broke slowly, was never far off the pace, rallied into the turn to get within striking distance and faded through the stretch. WE GOT DA FEVA saved ground, was crowded, bumped and hit the rail along the backstretch fell back and raced evenly thereafter. K O JUSTICE went five wide into the stretch and failed to menace in an even effort. OPERA JIM broke slowly and was not a factor. Following a stewards inquiry, SHORTY SMALL was disqualified and placed fifth.
