SHOWBOATER was never far back, lodged a five-wide bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear the final furlong. OAK FLAT vied for the lead while three wide into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and couldn't go with the winner the final furlong but was second best. CONGAREE DANCER was in the two path on the turn, eased out at the top of the stretch and gained some ground late. IMADEBUTANTE saved ground on the turn, lodged her bid along the rail then weakened some late. SHEMA REEF vied for the lead down the backstretch, remained in contention to mid stretch then weakened. LITTLE LOCA vied for the lead into the turn, took a clear lead into the turn, then fell back in upper stretch. MISS MAISY saved ground on the turn then eased out four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. RAINBOW WEAVER was a brief factor after the start but fell back into the turn and tired.
