Footnotes

BOBBY HANDY stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, dueled to the final strides and inched clear to prove best. BOREALIS WAY set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. IVORY FUDGE moved up along the backstretch to press the pace, dueled between horses through the stretch and was outfinished. WAILIN' JACK was unhurried early, advanced between horses on the turn but had little left for the drive. DOUBLE SHUFFLE was slow early, went four wide on the second turn, had nothing left and lacked a bid. LAYOVER IN SEATTLE failed to threaten in an even effort. GO TO THE PULPIT saved ground mid pack, bid inside on the turn, gave way and dropped back steadily.
