CHOO CHOO CHARLIE raced mid pack, rallied around the turn, went five wide entering the stretch, assumed command near the eighth pole, inched away and was all out at the wire. GAME SEVEN lagged early, went six wide leaving the turn, went willingly to the wire and was outfinished. ARTIC FIRE broke sharply, pressed the pace four across, leveled off in the drive but held safely for show. LEE CREEK advanced around the turn, bid off the rail to contend and stopped. OSO CATY pressed the pace between horses to the turn and gave way. TAPADERO was checked hard at the start, saved ground and lacked a bid under mild urging. CLEVER SPEED pressed the pace three wide between horses to the turn and stopped. PROXYMAN was hustled along inside, set a pressured pace to the upper stretch and stopped.
