Footnotes

HORSE B WITH YOU moved up outside on the clubhouse turn to challenge for the lead, reached the front on the backstretch, drew clear into the lane and gradually edged away through the final furlong. MS ZENNA'S ROYAL close up early and just off the inside midway on the clubhouse turn, raced between rivals entering the final turn, hesitated just slightly when a rival drifted out some inside the furlong marker then finished well for the place. SKY HIGH WONDER set the early pace, saved ground and responded when headed on the backstretch, fought back into the far turn, drifted out some briefly inside the eighth pole then weakened late. ARABIC DANCER trailed early, raced in the two path nearing the top of the lane while lodging a bid, moved in some turning for home, came out some in upper stretch then offered a mild gain. CLASSICAL TAP raced four wide into the lane, was steadied slightly in upper stretch and lacked the needed bid. BROKEN TEARS steadied inside on the clubhouse turn then dropped back while slow to settle, raced three deep entering the far turn and moved up some then offered little in the drive. SARASWATIANMAHAGAN a bit rank at the start and between rivals into the clubhouse turn, saved ground leaving the backstretch and was steadied while tiring turning for home. The race was hand timed.
