FOR THREE YEAR OLDS (NEED NOT BE ARIZONA BRED) CONCEIVED BY A NOMINATED STALLION STANDING IN THE STATE OF ARIZONA IN 2007. \$600 to enter. The ATBA will deduct 10% of all nominating and sustaining payments for clerical fees before the Stallion Stakes. The balance to be divided as follows: 50% to winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth; 10% to be paid to nominator of stallion. Starters to pass the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference given to those entries that have accumulated the highest earnings with winners preferred regardless of earnings. Fillies, 115 lbs. Colts & Geldings, 120 lbs.

### Footnotes

WHISKEY ROW raced close to the pace inside, awaited room on the turn, angled out in the upper stretch, closed willingly, drew off near the sixteenth pole and won going away. GOTTA SKEDADDLE set a pressured pace past the eighth pole, was outclosed but held for second. MIGHTY BUCK trailed the field, rallied four wide on the turn, bid willingly to loom a threat, couldn't gain ground but was clearly best of the rest. MODERN GENTLEMAN broke out, raced close to the pace, bid between horses to threaten, had nothing left for the drive and faded from contention. WEAR AND TEAR pressed the pace around the first turn, vied two across to the second turn, tired and gave way. STORMY CRYSTAL broke out, swung a bit wide on the first turn, pressed the pace to the second turn, swung wide and was not urged in the stretch.
