STRATEGIST bid along the rail entering the far turn, eased out slightly for the drive and reached the leaders inside the eighth pole then finished well while drawing out late. STRIKINGLY SINFUL tracked early, was asked on the final turn and reached the front in the stretch then was outfinished by the top one while second best. C MY SECRET set the pace and battled into midstretch then weakened. HEROI DO BAFRA (BRZ) three wide into the far turn, was in the four path into the lane and lacked the needed bid. CIRQUE DU SOLEIL (ARG) broke a bit slowly, raced in good position to the far turn and weakened.
