SKIMASCO was hustled along to press the pace, assumed command on the turn, drew off and held safely under steady urging. KORICANCHA was unhurried early to trail the field, angled out at the top of the stretch, bid eight wide and closed well to earn place. CROWN KING was never far off the pace, bid three wide leaving the turn but didn't have enough late. OUR MAGIC COUPLE saved ground, failed to rally and was not a threat. CONCLAVE set a pressured pace to the turn, swung wide and gave way. CHAMPSVILLE broke awkwardly, stalked the pace while racing outside, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and gave way. RAINIER MISSILE raced in the back, went nine wide at the top of the stretch, lacked a bid and was outrun.
