TOP PENNY eased out four wide for the drive and finished well while edging clear late. FUN'NGAMES TOKNITE always a factor and in the three path turning for home, reached the front passing the furlong marker and continued on gamely. MARQUET FIRST advanced turning for home, raced four wide into the lane and finished willingly while not good enough. SOCIETY CAT raced five wide into the stretch and was gaining late. SHIMMERING HEAT battled for the lead into midstretch and weakened. MISS FREEDOM raced just off the inside passing the quarter pole, was in the three path into the lane and lacked a solid bid. OFFSHORE NEWS saved ground and vied for the early lead then tired in the drive. MISS FRENCH saved ground on the turn, raced behind a rival entering the lane then lacked a bid. CORONA DEL HIELO saved ground on the turn and weakened through the lane. ARCH LADY trailed and lacked a response.
