LATINO SUMMER vied inside to the second turn, drew clear, was under pressure through the stretch, drifted out and held on gamely. SEISMIC THUNDER was unhurried early, rallied around the far turn, went five wide entering the stretch, closed willingly but didn't have enough late. WILD BUDDY was unhurried early, rallied around the far turn, angled out for the drive, closed well and got up in the final strides for show. GRANDPA ROY was well placed, rallied inside on the far turn, eased out for the drive, went willingly to the wire and lost position late. SUMMER STEPPER was never back, got through inside entering the stretch to get within striking distance but came up empty. LOUDER raced mid pack, bid inside, had little left for the drive and hung. ARROW JUNCTION passed tiring rivals. QUITE A DUDE vied to the second turn, tired and dropped back. PALADIN POWER was not a factor. WAILEA WARRIOR was outrun. PRESIDENTIAL CAUSE pulled up and was vanned off.
