KINGSVILLE set the pace, was under pressure late and held well in a driving finish. ROGUE RIVER pressed the pace, bid willingly and was outfinished. HAITIAN raced inside, was steadied into the second turn, stayed close to the pace, rallied three across on the final turn, fell back, went willingly to the wire and narrowed the gap. SHRYOCK was allowed to settle, advanced around the final turn, offered a mild bid only and failed to menace. COASTAL SOUVENIR failed to threaten in an even effort. SUB DUE FORCE stalked outside early, dropped back and went evenly thereafter. RINGOLEVIO pressed the pace, tired into the final turn and stopped.
