SOUTH SIDE SALLY saved ground and vied for the lead, held the advantage through the final furlong and was out all to prevail. STYLEFREE reached the front nearing the half mile pole, lost the lead in the stretch and drifted some leaving the eighth pole then came back on and just missed. DOUBLE ZADO well placed and near the rail on the turn, lacked the needed response. ARIAT GOLD chased and three wide on the turn, weakened in the drive. SWISS BLEND stumbled at the start to be away slowly, raced six wide turning for home and lacked a late response. UNUSUALLY BRITE bobbled at the start, saved ground and lacked the needed bid. DANNSAIR raced three wide into the turn, chased and weakened then was vanned off. PHOEBE'S SONG was steadied at the start then was outrun.
