GOOD TO GO set a pressured pace, drew off on the turn and extended his lead while being ridden out. PREVAILING WIND (GB) was never far back while racing outside, bid five wide, closed well but was no match for the winner. FIRE TALKER was slow early, bid six wide, found hid best stride late and got up near the wire for show. MINERO DE ORO broke in the air, stalked outside, fell back on the turn and lacked the needed late rally. ZAGORA'S PRIDE pressed the pace to the turn and gave way. SOFT DEFENSE saved ground, showed speed to the turn and gave way. IRISH SNOWFALL trailed the field, went seven wide in the drive, lacked a bid and showed little. SHARAN'S PRIDE flashed speed, was through early and outrun.
