WAR ENSIGN set the pace, raced just off the rail turning for home, came in impeding a rival inside the eighth pole then drew clear. HUNKASLEW never far back and between foes into the far turn, was checked and altered course inside the furlong marker due to a spill then gained some late. WESTERN STRIDER three deep into the far turn, raced near the rail turning for home then also was checked due to a spill inside the eighth pole. REIGN OF THE EDGE slow early, lacked a solid rally. THE QUEEN'S APPLE raced four wide into the lane, lacked the needed response and was steadied inside the eighth pole due to the spill. ASSAULT WEAPON pressed the early issue, gave way on the final turn and faded through the stretch. FUSAICHI SAINT awaited room while along the inside on the final turn, stayed on the rail and challenged for the lead in the stretch then was impeded inside the eighth pole unseating the rider. Following a stewards inquiry, WAR ENSIGN was disqualified from first and placed last for stretch interference.
