COMIC FOOL moved up to assume command, drew off around the turn, held a long lead and held safely under mild urging. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE settled off the pace, bid three wide on the turn and narrowed the gap to finish second best. MR. INN ZONE was never far back, bid along the rail on the turn, lacked a rally but held for show. JABANERO was rank at the start to be slow early, was hustled along, closed well and gained late. TRIGRANAUT broke awkwardly, slowly, trailed the field, found his best stride late and gained ground. EXITONEONINE raced in the middle of the pack, went four wide entering the stretch and failed to threaten in an even effort. QUICK VIC raced outside, went five wide leaving the turn, lacked a bid and was outrun. EL MOSQUITO saved ground to the stretch and was not a factor. BOLD BIG AL was away alertly, showed speed to the turn and stopped.
