PRIZE PLAY chased inside, bid between horses on the turn, drew clear mid stretch and held well. SHRYOCK raced mid pack, awaited room on the turn, angled out in the upper stretch and closed to earn second. WARREN'S JACK V. raced close to the pace, went five wide entering the stretch and got up for show under steady urging. C MY SECRET set the pace to mid stretch but was unable to sustain his bid. TWO TURNS was void of early speed, offered a mild bid six wide and improved position. BOLD AGREEMENT failed to menace in an even effort. ARENA NEGRA chased the pace to the second turn, flattened out and faded through the stretch. EXACTLY RIGHT chased the pace racing three across, went four wide leaving the turn and gave way. KENTUCKY MILE raced in the back, got through along the rail, lacked a bid and was outrun. BEFORE THE PROM went five wide on the first turn and was not a factor. GENKI was through after a half and steadily faded from contention.
