SHORT MEMO hesitated to be away slowly, made a strong outside run nearing the quarter pole and drew clear then widened as a driving winner while breaking stride slightly over track marks in deep stretch. STORMIN AHEAD set the pace then was no match to the top one while second best. NAVAJO KNIGHT four wide early, raced just off the rail turning for home and lacked the needed late response. JOSHUA'S JOURNEY tracked early, lodged a bid on the final turn and chased then weakened in the drive. ALL MIGHTY BUCK well placed and outside on the far turn, chased to the lane and weakened. GAMBLER BILL raced up close inside into the far turn and tired. M L'S MONEY MAKER five wide early, lacked a rally.
