WHY NOT BE PERFECT raced close to the pace, advanced outside to the final turn, went six wide at the top of the stretch, closed steadily, got up late and was all out at the wire. FLEXIPLUS was reluctant to load, broke very slowly, raced in the back, went eight wide at the top of the stretch, closed willingly and was gaining fast late. BULLITONE was never far off the pace, raced inside to save ground, awaited room on the final turn and in the upper stretch, closed well once clear and earned show. LAYOVER IN SEATTLE stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn to duel, got the lead late and was outfinished in a good effort. GRANDPA ROY was unhurried mid pack, went seven wide into the stretch and finished well. SUNDAY HEADLINE set the pace to mid stretch and was unable to sustain his bid. TOBIAH'S JOURNEY pressed the pace to mid stretch, leveled off and lost position. K JS MADDODG failed to menace in an even effort. SUPER CANDY was checked on the first turn and trailed the field.
