DEJA pressed the pace, bid between horses on the far turn, dueled to deep stretch and inched clear to prove best. FRIENDOFTHEFAMILY was well placed, challenged for the lead three wide on the second turn, dueled to deep stretch but couldn't match strides. HOSTILITY went four wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and was gaining for place. ARCH LADY lacked early speed, rallied after a half, went five wide leaving the turn and finished well. CASH FEVER was jostled a bit at the start, raced mid pack inside but failed to rally. GRINDAVIK raced mid pack, went five wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. HAGERSTOWN set the pace to the second turn and gave way. ROTOGA was outrun.
