TOP GONE always a factor and inside turning for home, finished gamely to prevail. MIA ICEMAN set the pace, saved ground and yielded grudgingly. CHACO D challenged for the lead three wide on the final turn then was not quite good enough. WOBBLY FELLOW four wide early, prompted the pace down the backstretch and into the lane then lacked the needed stretch response. ARTISTIC CAUSE broke awkwardly, moved out late and was gaining at the end. SIR STORMEY KNIGHT saved ground and lacked a response. KALOOKAN BOXER saved ground into the far turn and lacked a bid. ELECTRIC SPARK fractious at the gate, hesitated some at the start and raced rank early, lacked a rally then collapsed afterwards from an apparent heat stroke
