FOR THREE YEAR OLDS (NEED NOT BE ARIZONA BRED) CONCEIVED BY A NOMINATED STALLION STANDING IN THE STATE OF ARIZONA IN 2008. \$600 to enter. The ATBA will deduct 10% of all nominating and sustaining payments for clerical fees before the Stallion Stakes. The balance to be divided as follows: 50% to winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth; 10% to be paid to nominator of stallion. Starters to pass the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference given to those entries that have accumulated the highest earnings with winners preferred regardless of earnings. Fillies, 115 lbs. Colts & Geldings, 120 lbs. \$600 plus jock's mount due at time of entry.

A POLITICAL TIME was away well, raced in hand early, vied to the second turn, inched clear and was ridden out. SHE'S A HIT was unhurried early while never far back, finished well inside under steady urging and got up for place. TEN NINETY SEVEN stalked the pace, rallied into the turn to challenge for the lead, leveled off but held for show. HINDU KUSH stalked the pace while racing inside, angled out on the turn, bid six wide and hung in the lane. DESERT LIGHTNING was steadied on the first turn, raced in the back, got through along the rail on the second turn but had nothing left for the drive. PLAY N WIN pressed the pace between horses, tired into the turn and gave way. ANNAPOLIS FLYER vied three across, was through after a half and gave way.
