BRASS PLATE went seven wide entering the stretch, closed, assumed command near the sixteenth pole, was under pressure but held on gamely. EDGERIN J went eight wide leaving the turn, bid gamely, couldn't get by the winner and settled for second best. DOUBLE SHUFFLE fell far back early, went nine wide in the drive and got up late for show. ALL SAINT set the pace with a clear lead, faltered near the sixteenth pole and lost position. ENFORCER advanced around the final turn, closed well but didn't have enough left. GRANDPA ROY was never far back, swung six wide entering the stretch, bid and came up empty. CALL ME LATER chased the pace, tired into the final turn and dropped back. SUB DUE FORCE was through early, steadily faded and was not a threat. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER distanced the field and walked off.
