HOLY SAINT set the pace, was under pressure late and just lasted. GUIDING HAND stalked the pace, put in a steady effort and was gaining late. DUNSCOMBE was unhurried early, advanced inside, angled out, went seven wide in the drive and was along for show. LESSON IN DECEIT was unhurried early, went eight wide in the drive and offered a mild bid only. JUST HEAT saved ground mid pack, advanced inside around the turn, eased out for the drive, bid and came up empty. CANARD stalked the pace to the second turn and flattened out. DELUXE BUS raced in close outside, tired on the turn and gave way.
