TRIFECTA PHIL tracked early, was asked on the turn then was no match while holding the place. SNEAKIN BY raced five wide into the stretch and was gaining late. TIE ROD near the inside and between rivals passing the quarter pole, lacked the needed response. TEST BOY trailed early, raced near the inside on the turn and offered a belated gain. STRIKINOUT N MIAMI stumbled to break awkwardly, saved ground and lacked the needed bid. KINGSBURG bumped at the start, saved ground and lacked a rally. TAKEITTOHEBANK stumbled to be away awkwardly then failed to menace.
