TRIPLE BEAU joined the leaders four deep on the backstretch then finished determinedly to prevail. CALMWIND moved to the lead three deep while between foes on the final turn, responded gamely in the drive then just missed. SUPER FOOL advanced inside into midstretch to loom a solid threat then could not sustain her bid. FLEETING WONDER offered mild late gain. PINK LIPSTICK saved ground while vying for the lead and tired in the drive. REAL GORGEOUS vied for the early lead, raced between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch and rounding the final turn then weakened in the drive. WINDY CITY GAL never far back, lacked a bid. LADY LOW broke inward then bobbled slightly, saved ground and lacked rally.
