SPANISH JAZZ was never far off the pace, rallied around the turn, went five wide entering the stretch, assumed command and drew off under mild urging. RICH'S BOY broke out, stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, swung wide, dropped back and was no match for the winner. LIVIN' LOVIN' MAN showed good early speed inside, fell back, went three wide into the stretch and earned show in a steady effort. RADIANT RASCAL was slow early, went six wide leaving the turn, bid and came up empty. ROGUE TWISTER vied two across to the turn, stopped in the upper stretch and was not urged late. WICKED GOOD bobbled and was in tight at the start, raced in the back, advanced to the turn, dropped back, angled out, went nine wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid. PLENTY DUE vied inside to the turn and stopped.
