MEGAMIGO vied inside to the turn, drew clear and held well in a driving finish. MIKE'S TRIPPIN was unhurried out of the gate, rallied eight wide and closed to get up at the wire for place. HEISMAN U lagged early, went seven wide in the drive, closed to narrow the gap and was caught at the wire for second. SMARTY MATT was never far back, got through along the rail on the turn, bid to loom a threat but hung late. OH LORD raced within striking distance but lacked the needed late response. ECHO WEST vied outside, dropped back on the turn and hung in the lane. HIGH REGARDS vied between horses to the turn, fell back and faded from contention. GERI'S DRIVER showed little.
