**Footnotes**

R LA PATRONA broke alertly and rated off the leaders while in the three path, came four wide into the stretch, lodged her bid and edged clear the final furlong. CACTUS BREEZE was bumped at the break, then moved to the rail, saved ground to the stretch then eased out for the drive and finished well. WEAR AND TEAR was bumped at the break, took the three path on the turn and into the stretch then finished willingly. PATTY COME HOME forced the early issue then lugged out on the turn and came into the stretch well past mid track, was straightened and was outfinished for the show spot. CHARMANT was four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. SWISS QUEEN broke with the field and moved to the rail after the start, stayed inside and was not a factor. RUN DUDE RUN saved ground on the turn, stayed on the rail for the drive and tired. CLASS OF SECRETS set the pace to upper stretch, stopped abruptly when headed and was being eased up late.
