HIGHLY DECORATED trailed early, advanced outside foes on the turn, raced six wide entering the stretch and drew off while under mild hand urging to the late stages. BRITEBURG vied early, was steadied off heels turning for home while five wide then finished willingly while second best. VALLEY STATION raced just off the inside turning for home and challenged for the lead then was not good enough. COOPER'S STORM raced five wide into the stretch and gained some late. STATELY TOM raced three wide on the turn and chased then tired in the drive. CLEAN ENERGY saved ground and vied for the lead on the turn then weakened in the drive. SORULLO pulled early and vied for the lead, drifted out into the stretch and tired. FORGET THE CAT raced between rivals into the turn and weakened.
