SHE'S A HIT raced mid pack, rallied around the turn, went five wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and got up in the final strides. GOOD MANGO bumped at the start, pressed inside, assumed command into the turn, led to the final strides and was outfinished. ENGLISH RHYTHM bid inside on the turn, altered course in the upper stretch, went willingly to the wire and was outfinished in a game effort. ORIENT ROSE was away alertly to set a pressured pace, fell back into the turn, stayed close and hung late. MYSTERY CHANNEL was rated early, raced mid pack inside, bid along the rail on the turn and didn't have enough late. MENTA BE PERFECT bumped at the start and was steadied, raced wide and lacked a bid. SOCIETY ROSE was checked on the first turn, raced evenly and distanced the field. WILDERNESS ROSE broke in, fell far back, trailed and distanced the field.
