TULELAKE was crowded at the start, raced mid pack, went five wide leaving the turn, closed willingly to get up late and won going away. THE BRICKSTER pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outclosed. CAT SKYLAR veered in at the start, set the pace, responded when challenged to duel to late stretch and yielded grudgingly. LONESOME CREEK pressed the pace inside, bid willingly and was outfinished for show. REASON TO CRY broke in, stalked the pace, went five wide leaving the turn but didn't have enough late. VOLLEYBALL LINDY broke slowly and was crowded at the start, bid inside entering the stretch but came up empty. T. J.'S VISION was crowded at the start and failed to menace in an even effort. RUN MO RUN was not a factor. SPRING CREEK veered out at the start and trailed the field.
