Footnotes

SPOKANE DANCER was unhurried early, rallied through traffic around the turn, went six wide in the drive, closed steadily to wear down CANT CATCH JUDY and got up in the final strides. CANT CATCH JUDY moved up along the rail on the backstretch to vie for the lead, inched clear leaving the turn, drifted out late under left handed urging, led to deep stretch and was outfinished. BYE BYE LADIES raced close the pace between horses, was boxed in, lacked room in the stretch, angled out near the sixteenth pole once able and closed to get up for late for show. SATIN CREATION saved ground, was blocked from the turn to near the sixteenth pole and went willingly to the wire. ESCAPE PLAN set the pace while racing well off the rail, swung wide entering the stretch, fell back continued willingly but couldn't gain ground. ROLLIN STOCK was slow early, bid along the rail on the turn and lacked room through the stretch. SUN CITY bid between horses into the turn to challenge for the lead, fell back and leveled off. SO DIVINE broke a bit slowly, was hustled along to stalk the pace, stopped entering the turn and was not urged late. PER ADOR RULING NUMBER 7 DATED OCTOBER 14, SPOKANE DANCER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND UNPLACED.
