IVA ATTITUDE was never far back, angled out on the turn, swung wide into the lane, dueled through the stretch and proved best. MIIPHASE set a pressured pace, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. MAMA JANKA was void of early speed, put in a steady effort and was along for show while no threat to the top two. ILIKEWHOILIKE raced outside, went eight wide in the drive and failed to rally. NATURAL PEARL vied two across to the turn, gave way and faded through the stretch. LITTLEMISSGOGO had brief speed only. AUNT AMY raced mid pack outside, went six wide at the top of the lane and lacked a bid. GUMDROP FALLS veered in at the start, saved ground, advanced along the rail and had no stretch response.
