COUNTY KILDARE drew well clear in the run to the turn, showed the way to the lane and was kept busy while remaining well clear. SIMPLY ANGELINA chased from the outside and was second best. PROUD Y BONITA chased near the rail and lacked the needed late response. COUNTESS CAPOTE was outrun into the lane then was gaining late from the outside. SHEMA REEF raced four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PROUD BLUE RIDGE saved ground and lacked the needed bid. LITTLE LOCA stumbled at the start, raced between rivals on the turn and lacked a rally. TRACK MAJESTY saved ground into the turn and just off the rail into the stretch, lacked a rally.
