WAR SIGNAL lagged outside, rallied around the turn to challenge, dueled to the sixteenth pole and drew clear. NEMRAC raced in the back, went seven wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and finished second best. SERGE TO PARADISE set a pressured pace, drew clear into the turn, responded when challenged to duel, faltered near the sixteenth pole but held safely for show. KELA DAWN advanced into the turn, angled in, bid inside to loom a threat but came up empty late. FRIENDS PUB ducked out at the start, pressed the pace inside, fell back into the turn and faded through the stretch. LOUIE SUNRISE fell far back early and showed little in an even effort. SINALOENSE broke slowly, saved ground and showed brief speed only.
