VICKIE VEE vied for the early lead, held a clear advantage nearing the stretch, responded in upper stretch and drew off late. UPPIE LOU saved ground on the turn, stayed on the rail for the stretch and earned the place. APOLLO'S GIRL vied for the lead to the stretch then lacked a further late response. BEWITCHING GEM came in and bumped a foe at the break, was four deep into the turn, came five wide for the stretch and lacked a bid. MISS ALL THE POWER was three deep contesting the pace into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and tired the final furlong. FLY FANNIE FLY was five wide on the turn and six wide into the stretch while not a factor. ANA MARTHA was bumped at the break, raced inside and never seriously threatened.
