PLATINUM HIT moved up while five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch, lodged her bid nearing the furlong grounds and edged clear late. CROWN SECRET broke slowly, moved quickly into contention with a three-wide move into the turn, lodged her bid at the top of the stretch and gave ground grudgingly in the final strides. BUCK'S CINDY moved up on the turn nearing the stretch, came six wide into the stretch and finished well. SASSY BRITCHES set the pace to the top of the stretch, responded when challenged then weakened late. GUZZLE N GO trailed and angled seven wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. BERCAUSE was just off the early leaders, took the two path into the stretch and weakened. VOLLEYBALL LINDY was also just off the leaders into the turn, stayed on the rail for the stretch and weakened. NEAT PART reared up while a bit fractious in the gate before the start then broke in at the start and didn't seriously threaten.
